SBYSF Scholarships funded by Santa Barbara Yacht Club Women

Dear Scholarship Applicant,

The Santa Barbara Yacht Club Women are pleased you are inquiring about scholarship opportunities for the SBYSF sailing programs. Scholarships are available for girls and boys from age eight to eighteen. Our goal, and the goal of the Santa Barbara Youth Sailing Foundation, is to help young people in our community develop, through the sport of sailing, attributes of self-reliance, responsibility, teamwork, and sportsmanship, together with a constant awareness of the requirements of safety.

The SBYCW Scholarships are reserved for applicants who have a keen interest in learning to sail, have no prior or limited sailing experience and may have financial barriers that may be limiting their opportunity to explore the program. The Scholarships can be used for tuition with our year-round programs but are more widely accessed for our "Learn to Sail" programs during the Summer Semester. The Scholarships may also be awarded for Semester tuition for those sailors currently enrolled in SBYSF programs who are experiencing financial barriers to continuing enrollment. The Scholarships are reviewed and approved by a joint committee of volunteers on the SBYSF Board and SBYCW Scholarship Committee.

Again, the SBYCW Scholarships are reserved for "Learn to Sail" applicants and certain financial need instances while Grants available from SBYSF are available for sailors participating in regattas outside of local and regional sailing. They are separate and distinct requests.

Full and partial Scholarship awards will be based on several factors, including but not limited to funds available, number of requests received and needs of the applicant/individual/family. If you are able to pay a portion of the tuition we encourage you to submit for a partial scholarship so we are able to provide opportunities for all applicants throughout the year.

Here is what you need to do:

- 1. Complete the Youth Sailing Foundation registration form and turn it in. All the information you need about classes, mailing address, etc. can be found on the SBYSF website at www.sbysf.com.
- 2. Complete the Scholarship Application, and send it in along with the other information required (personal/parent letter, school recommendation or personal referral letter; see application for details) to the address on the application.

We hope you will join us to discover the challenge and excitement of sailing, and we look forward to meeting you! Please let us know if you have any questions. - 2. A letter from the Sailor about why they are interested in the sailing program or why they want to learn to sail.
- 3. A letter of recommendation from a school principal, counselor, or teacher; or, if this is not easily obtainable, a letter from someone other than a family member who knows you well is desired. Although this letter is not required, additional supporting documents will insure strong consideration.
